STANDING ORDERS FOR NALOXONE

This standing order is issued by Dr. Lisa Villarroel, MD MPH (NPI #1598085896), Chief Medical Officer of Public Health Services at the Arizona Department of Health Services. The standing order authorizes any Arizona-licensed pharmacist to dispense naloxone to any individual in accordance with the conditions of this order.

One of the following naloxone products can be dispensed to eligible persons based on product availability and preference.

	For intranasal administration <u>Dispense:</u> Naloxone Hydrochloride 4mg/0.1mL nasal spray <u>Sig:</u> For suspected opioid overdose, administer a single spray of Naloxone in one nostril. Repeat after 3 minutes if no or minimal response. <u>Refills:</u> PRN x 1 year
	For intramuscular injection <u>Disp:</u> 0.4mg/mL in 1mL single dose vials. Include one 3cc, 23g, 1" syringe per dose dispensed. <u>Sig:</u> For suspected opioid overdose, inject 1mL IM in shoulder or thigh, PRN opioid overdose. Repeat after 3 minutes if no or minimal response. <u>Refills:</u> PRN x 1 year
	Other FDA approved medication for the reversal of opioid overdose <u>Refills:</u> PRN x 1 year
